

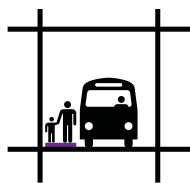

HEALTHY BUILT ENVIRONMENT LINKAGES

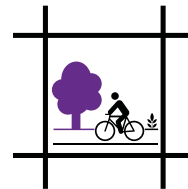

Accessible online, this toolkit of resources is designed to facilitate conversations between health professionals and planners, and inform the decision making process around the built environment.

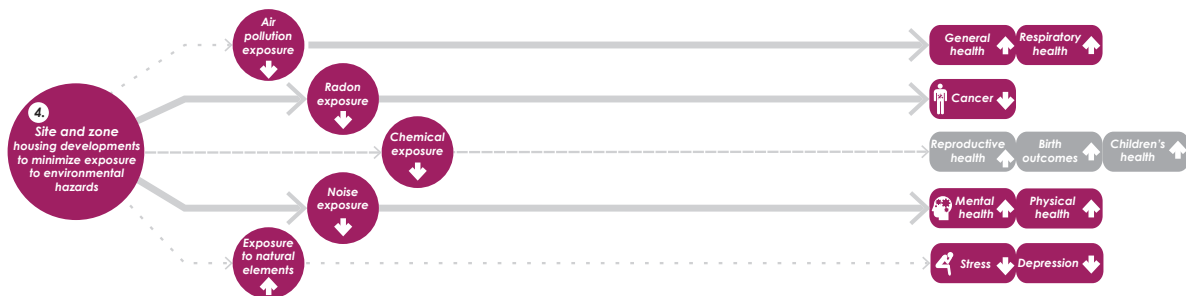

## WHAT DO HEALTHY TRANSPORTATION NETWORKS LOOK LIKE?

### Vision:

*Safe and accessible transportation systems that incorporate a diversity of transportation modes and place priority on active transport (e.g., cycling, walking and transit) over the use of private vehicles.*
