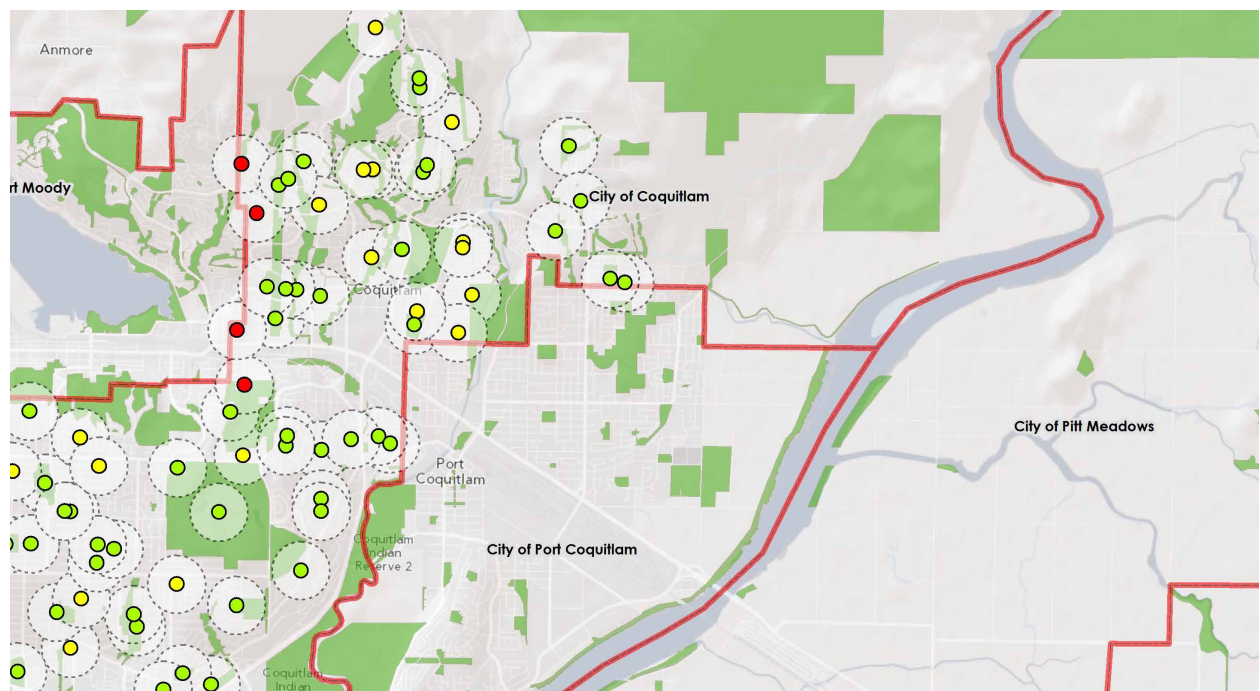


# REGIONAL OUTDOOR RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES STUDY

The goal of the Regional Outdoor Recreation Study was to advise Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) on the ability of their regional park programs to adequately address regional outdoor recreation needs, and to suggest improvements to their park land base and services.

The report examined the forms of outdoor recreation in which residents of the study area participate, inventories the facilities and terrains available and assesses the fit between user demand and the supply of opportunities, now and into the future (2041). This information was gathered through a scientifically-controlled survey of Metro Vancouver and FVRD residents conducted in 2010. In the second phase of the study, data was collected from various government agencies, collated, and linked to a searchable digital mapping tool developed for this project. The mapping tool will be a lasting legacy of this project, even beyond the supply and demand results published as a part of this project, which will be used to inform parks and recreation plans for both Metro Vancouver and the FVRD.
