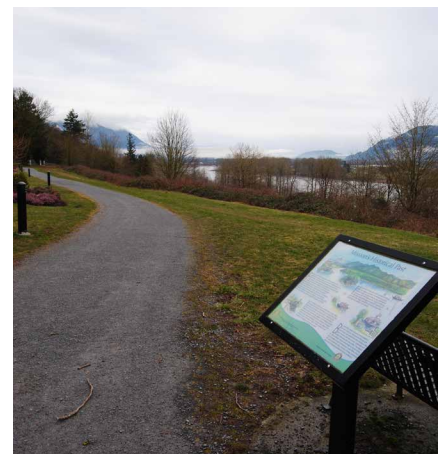

## EAST MISSION HERITAGE GREENWAY

LEES+Associates were commissioned by the District of Mission to provide conceptual design, construction documents and cost estimating services for the East Mission Heritage Greenway in Mission, British Columbia. The shared use recreational routes totaling 3 km, connect two of Mission's residential neighborhoods that were previously accessible only by roads or highway arterials. The trail provides a commuter link for cycling, as well as provides active recreational opportunities for residents for all ages by formalizing looped trail routes through the existing site and engaging the site's existing natural and historic attractions.

The Greenway Trail matches the character of the existing landscape. The granular path surfaces integrate with the natural landscape while providing a compact surface appropriate for a diverse range of users and abilities. An environmentally sensitive stream crossing, bank stabilization and native planting palette enhances the local ecosystem and establishes a foundation for future environmental initiatives. Viewing areas with benches and interpretative panels provide rest areas for nature viewing and education. The awarded construction budget is set at \$956,987.00. Lees+Associates' estimate of probable construction cost was within a 3% margin of error.
