

TOWN OF PRINCETON PARKS AND RECREATION STRATEGY

Known as the “gateway to the Okanagan-Similkameen Valley,” the Town of Princeton is home to approximately 2,724 residents. A resource based economy - the reopening and expansion of two local mines is resulting in an influx of new residents. The 2013 Parks and Recreation Strategic Plan provides long range planning, vision, and guidance to the Town in managing and developing parks and recreation facilities, programs, infrastructure and resources, while guiding appropriate investment. The development of the plan included direction from Town Council and Town Staff, the examination of provincial trend and comparisons to other similar sized communities. The consulting team met with Town Council, select stakeholder groups and Staff. Additional stakeholders and the general public were consulted via two online web questionnaires and an open house event.
