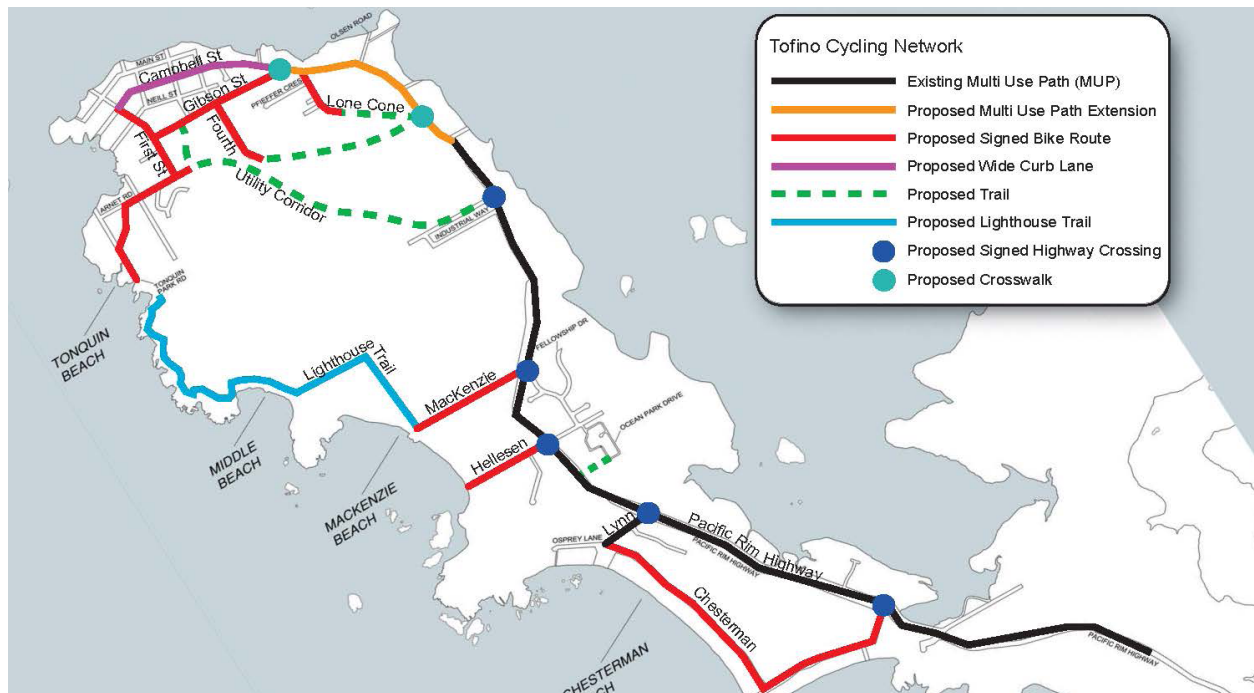


TOFINO CYCLING NETWORK PLAN

Relatively flat topography, a mild climate, and the need to adapt to burgeoning population growth brought about the need for the District of Tofino to enhance cycling opportunities. The District retained LEES+Associates to develop a comprehensive Cycling Network Plan to enable the municipality to take immediate and effective action on building a safe, convenient and attractive cycling network. The network is built off an existing 5km multi-use Pathway. The Cycling Plan focuses on extending the MUP into the downtown core, as well as an overall plan for cycling within the District. During an Open House, one resident attested, "We can't have enough walking/biking paths."

The main objective of the plan was to develop strategies for:

- Building on the existing cycling infrastructure;
- Maintaining year-round cycling routes;
- Wayfinding and signage, and
- Facilitating cycling transportation through engineering, design, low cost improvements, public awareness and education, and community promotion.
